



Cheryl Torain is a resident of Baltimore, MD and is a widow with two adult daughters and four grandchildren. She is a member of and accountable to Pastor Wayne Cockrell of Genesis Bible Fellowship Church of Baltimore, MD. Cheryl currently serves as the Director of the Women's Ministry.
